History

Vietnamese language known today was recognized only 150 years ago.



Speakers There are 68M speakers.



Alphabet

The Vietnamese alphabet uses the Latin script. There are 29 letters but no F, J, W, and Z.



Vowels and Consonants

There are 12 simple vowels and a variety of diphthongs and triphthongs along with 17 simple consonants. And one consonant with 3 letters – ngh, 9 consonants with 2 letters.



The tone

There are 6 different tones. A change of tone will not only change the meaning of the word but the different tones could reflect different intentions such as a plain informative sentence, a rhetorical question, an ironic statement and etc.



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Phonetic pairs

There are 3 phonetic pairs with different writing: $ia - y\hat{e} - i\hat{e}$, $ua - u\hat{o}$, $ua - u\sigma$.



Diphthongs and triphthongs

like: ai[aĭ] ; au[au̯] ; iêu[iəu̯] ; oai[wɑĭ] ; ươi[ɯəi].

The mix

Vietnamese is influenced by both English and Chinese, making it a language that has a wide range of loan words. However, the choice and use of these words seem to be determined by the context and the speaker's personal interest.

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
